

Erich-Muehsam-Prize

In spring 2007 the „Committee for Basic Rights and Democracy“ received for its campaign „Vacation from War“ the „Erich-Muehsam-Award“, which is dedicated to the anarchistic writer Erich Muehsam, who was one of the first victims of the Nazi-terror.

The celebration took place in the Buddenbrook-house in Luebeck. On her way Helga Dieter discovered a “Stolperstein” in front of the Buddenbrook-house. This was especially moving for her because in “Roedelheim”, where she lives she founded an initiative for those “Stolpersteine”. These stones stand for a remembrance of Nazi-victims in front of the houses where they had lived. The sculptor Gunter Demnig already set in more than 500 “Stolpersteine” (stumble-stones) in many cities,
